

**KENOSHA COUNTY FOSTER PARENT
TRAINING GUIDELINE**
(EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY)

Both foster parents are required to earn **12** training hours per year through the following recommended activities:

ACTIVITY	TIME GRANTED	RESTRICTIONS
<p>Formal Training (ex. Classroom training through Kenosha County Foster Parent Association, CIP, DCFS, or other agencies) Or First Aide, CPR, and Blood borne Pathogens.</p>	<p>For every hour of class receive 1 hour of credit.</p>	<p>A minimum of <u>4</u> hours <i>must be earned this way.</i></p> <p>You may obtain all your training hours this way.</p>
<p>DCFS Case Activity (ex. Court, Therapy Sessions, Child and Family Team meetings) *Please have your social worker or therapist sign for you.*</p>	<p>For every activity attended receive 1 hour of credit.</p>	<p>No more than <u>3</u> hours per year can be earned this way.</p>
<p>Media (ex. Books, Articles, Video, CD's, Tapes, ETC)</p>	<p>1 Book = 1 hour of credit 1 Article = 1 hour of credit 1 Video = 1 hour of credit 1 CD Set = 1 hour of credit 1 Tape Set = 1 hour of credit</p>	<p>No more than <u>3</u> hours per year can be earned this way. A brief synopsis must be submitted on each one completed before credit can be granted.</p>
<p>Foster Parent Association and/or CIP special activity (ex. Foster Care Picnic, Christmas Party, Booth Volunteering or other community outreach events)</p>	<p>For every activity attended receive 1 hour of credit.</p>	<p>No more than <u>4</u> hours per year can be earned this way.</p>
